



HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP 2024 AWARD REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY/LIMITATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Applicant and sponsor must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Applicants must be a senior graduating from a high school or home school program during the 2023-2024 school year.
2. Applicants must be a dependent with a current identification and privilege card. Please do not include a copy of the card.
3. The sponsor of the applicant must meet ONE of the following eligibility requirements:
 - Active duty U.S. Military member currently assigned or attached to Luke AFB
 - Active duty U.S. Military member on a remote assignment from Luke AFB
 - Retired U.S. Military member residing in the Luke AFB area
 - Full time Arizona National Guard member residing in the Luke AFB area
 - U.S. Military Reserve member attached to, or residing in the, Luke AFB area
 - Deceased U.S. Military member with applicant residing in the Luke AFB area

The following applicants are NOT eligible for an award:

1. Anyone who has previously been selected for an LSC scholarship award
2. Anyone on a full scholarship
3. Selection Committee Members or their family members
4. LSC Scholarship Committee Members or their family members

CRITERIA FOR AWARD

Scholarship award shall be based upon the following criteria:

1. Academics - 30%
2. Essay - 25%
3. Community Service/Citizenship - 20%
4. Extra-Curricular Activities - 15%
5. Personal Achievements - 10%

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The LSC and the Scholarship Committee are not responsible for lost or misdirected applications. It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure their application is complete. **Incomplete applications, or those received after the deadline will not be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application is complete prior to submission. Application must be RECEIVED by February 15, 2024.**

Applications must include **ALL** of the following:

1. Copy of sponsor's military orders showing assignment to Luke AFB or retirement paperwork (DD 214)
2. Official military document, such as DEERS enrollment, proving applicant's dependent status if not shown on sponsor's military orders or DD214
3. Proof of residency (example: copy of utility bill with home address)
4. High school transcript
5. Copy of official ACT or SAT report (if taken)
6. 2 Letters of recommendation from teacher, counselor, employer, community member or service professional, etc. (family/friend references not accepted)
7. Applicant Information Sheet (Attached)
8. Activity Information Sheet (Attached)
9. Applicant Essay. Type a two page essay on an 8 ½ x 11 single-sided, double spaced page with one inch margins using Times New Roman 12 point font. Essays exceeding more than two pages will not be accepted.

10. Homeschool students please note - in addition to the previous instructions, a copy of a notice of intent to homeschool that was provided to a local school is required.

ESSAY QUESTION

The Luke Spouses' Club motto is "Be the change. Make a difference." We believe that no matter who you are or what your circumstances happen to be, you have the power needed to be the change that makes a difference in yourself and your community. Explain how you plan to be the change that makes a difference in your world.

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF AWARDS

The LSC Scholarship Committee will approve the total number of scholarships and total amount awarded.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee is an outside, independent group and has no affiliation with Luke AFB or the Luke Spouses' Club. Decisions of the Selection Committee are final.

AWARD RECIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The scholarship must be used by the recipient enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at an accredited college or university, to include Master's and PhD level programs, during the fall semester of 2024 and/or spring semester of 2025.
2. The scholarship may be used for the payment of tuition, books, room and board, and any other school related fees charged by the Finance or Business Office of the school.
3. Recipients must submit, to the Scholarship Chair, the Statement of Intent & Use of Awards Agreement form no later than September 15, 2024. Use of Statement of Intent & Use of Awards form will be given to each recipient following the announcement of winners.
4. An official Enrollment Verification from the educational institution's Registrar must be sent to the Scholarship Chair and received by September 15, 2024. Electronic verification through the National Student Clearinghouse will also be accepted. Any fee associated with this service is the responsibility of the recipient.
5. The LSC Treasurer shall issue a check in the full amount of the scholarship payable to the school after the Statement of Intent & Use of Awards and verification is received.
6. Any scholarships not claimed by **September 15, 2024** will be forfeited.
7. Recipients who plan to attend only the Spring 2025 semester must provide written intent of this to the Scholarship Coordinator by September 15, 2024 and verification of enrollment by January 30, 2025.
